Our Finishing Touches

Traditional - Our most popular finish is carefully retouched not only to remove blemishes and soften under the eyes, but also to smooth lines from the skin and enhance the eyes. All portraits 8x10 and larger will be mounted for easier framing and sealed with a protective lacquer coating.

Watercolor - Our watercolor prints blend the portrait photography with fine art printmaking to produce a portrait that must be seen to be believed. The portraits are printed on fine art archival watercolor paper and will last as long as your photograph. Watercolor prints are carefully retouched and sealed with a protective lacquer coating.

Canvas - Your portrait is mounted on canvas to give you the painting-like feel of being in a gallery. Your portrait is carefully retouched and sealed to protect it from scratches, moisture and fading by a brilliant and flawless lacquer finish suitable for framing without glass.

Making The Most of Your Session

Clothing choice is one of the most important factors that can make or break a memorable portrait.

Clothing for the individual portrait which work well are medium to darker colors. They have a slimming effect and has always been a good choice for portraits when a medium to dark background is used.

Bold patterns, such as plaids or stripes are visually confusing. Bright colors have a tendency to overpower the subject's face and do not photograph well, while light colors that overpower the face will make the subject appear pale. Couples and smaller family groups should choose simple clothing in the same tonal ranges. If both light and dark colors are worn, there is a confusion visually as the light color tends to come forward and dark colors recede. For example, a person in a lighter color will have a more dominating appearance and also will appear heavier than the person in the darker clothing.

Small children and infants photograph the best in simple clothing which will not overpower their delicate features. For toddlers, casual play clothes work well. Older children and teens should wear clothing which will reflect their mood, personal achievement and their activities.

When there is more than one child being photographed, the clothing must be coordinated within the same style and tonal range so all children will "belong."

Clothing coordination is critical in a family portrait. Choosing colors within the same tonal range will assure that no one person in the portrait will stand out.

Hair is another important feature to consider. Hair style is a matter of choice and should fit your personality. Just before your portrait session, though, is not a good time to "introduce" a new style unless you are comfortable with the outcome. Children should wear a style that is also comfortable to them.

Men should be clean shaven or have any facial hair well groomed. A hair cut looks best when it is a week old.
